



Narrow gauge modelling in 7mm scale and similar scales has increased in popularity in recent years, especially since the formation of the 7mm Narrow Gauge Association in 1979. Since then, the Association has developed a world-wide following, with the objective of helping and inspiring those who enjoy this branch of the hobby. Among the attractions of this and similar scales is that models can have a feeling of weight and depth, often lacking in the smaller scales. Working with prototypically tight curves and small rolling stock allows the builder to create a realistic layout in a modest space, without making too many demands on eyesight and 12 inches to the foot fingers!

The services provided for Association members include a bi-monthly colour magazine, *Narrow Lines*, a newsletter and access to the Association Sales, which is now extensive, covering our own publications, modelling goods and a thriving second-hand sales service. In addition to articles on layouts and building projects, the magazine includes news and reviews of new products. The Association Sales is predominantly mail order, but we also attend the major narrow gauge modelling exhibitions, including our own Exhibition and Convention in May every year.
